For INAS-FID Registered Athletes in Great Britain only

IPC, INAS-FID and BRITISH RECORD APPLICATION PROCESS
For INAS-FID REGISTERED ATHLETES IN GB ONLY - SWIMMING

These procedures should be followed to make an application for an International Paralympic Committee (IPC), INAS-FID World or Regional and British Record for any athlete with learning disability in the UK who holds an "April 2005" INAS-FID Blue Registration Card.

The following are the types of records that can be applied for:

1. INAS-FID WORLD & EUROPEAN RECORD

- a) Use the INAS-FID Record Application for "World & Regional" Records. (Get from UKSA)
- b) Complete the Form in full
- c) Make sure all relevant signatories are in place.
- d) Attach a full copy of the results to the form, highlighting either in a different colour, or with a post it on the relevant page, where the swimmers record was achieved.
- e) Keep a photocopy for your reference.
- f) Send the original recorded delivery, with the UKSA Record Submission form to:

Timescale:

Make sure completed application reaches UKSA within 5 days of the record being achieved. INAS-FID will contact UKSA once a record has been ratified. UKSA will contact swimmers.

2. BRITISH RECORD

- a) Use the British Swimming Record Application Form. (Downloadable from their site or from UKSA)
- b) Complete the Form in full
- c) Make sure all relevant signatories are in place.

- d) Attach a full copy of the results to the form, highlighting either in a different colour, or with a post it on the relevant page, where the swimmers record was achieved.
- e) Keep a photocopy for your reference.
- f) Send the original recorded delivery, with the UKSA Record Submission form to:

Timescale:

Make sure completed application reaches UKSA within 5 days of the record being achieved.

Note: Swimming records can only be ratified from events that are ASA, WASA or SASA, or IPC licensed/approved events. British Swimming will contact you direct once a record has been ratified.

3. INTERNATIONAL PARALYMPIC COMMITTEE (IPC) WORLD & REGIONAL RECORDS

As a result of the IPC ban on athletes with intellectual disability S14 swimmers are unable to compete at IPC or Paralympic Game events. The IPC will not ratify record applications unless they are from an IPC sanctioned event.

UKSA is prepared to still submit records to IPC for their files in the hope that when the ban is removed, those records that were submitted according to IPC procedures may be considered retrospectively.

- a) Use the IPC Record Application Form. (Downloadable from their site or from UKSA)
- b) Complete the Form in full
- c) Make sure all relevant signatories are in place.
- d) Attach a full copy of the results to the form, highlighting either in a different colour, or with a post it on the relevant page, where the swimmers record was achieved.
- e) Keep a photocopy for your reference.

f) Send the original recorded delivery, with the UKSA Record Submission form to:

Timescale:

Make sure completed application reaches UKSA within 5 days of the record being achieved.

Note: Remember records can only be ratified from events that are IPC sanctioned events. Because of the IPC ban, UKSA can only submit the record application to IPC for their reference. Once the ban is removed, UKSA will ask for those records to be ratified. There is no guarantee that IPC will agree to this request.

It is important that you follow the guidelines and make sure you get the information to UKSA within the timescales. Please remember to fill in the UKSA Record Submission Form too each time you send an application to UKSA.
